MATERNITY CENTRE VIDEO

We have another wonderful video by Philip Lee Harvey to share with you. This one is about our Maternity Centre and is narrated by Dr Edith Formum, our Clinical Director.

In just 5 months, the Maternity Centre had 1,743 antenatal visits with 305 babies safely delivered. These are such heart-warming figures for an area that had some of the highest maternal and neo-natal death rates in the world. Please watch our short video here:

ITC CENTRE

Our new ITC centre is almost finished! Painting has been completed on the external building, showing off the striking design. And we have 40 computers arriving next month when the building will start functioning. It will be the first dedicated state-of-the art computer learning centre in Uganda, teaching pupils in the daytime and adults in the evening and weekends, so they can learn new skills to help them find future employment.

Great progress is also being made on the administration building at the Namatala secondary school site, with construction due to be completed by the end of July.
