1 - THE IT CENTRE SITE

Construction on the Information and Technology Centre is making excellent progress. The carpenters that were trained on our Economic Development project have been working hard on the roof structure, completing it just a few days ago.





SITE 2 - THE ADMIN BLOCK

Our second construction project is the Administration Block on the Namatala Secondary School site. Work is being carried out around the area that will become the entrance.









SITE 3 - THE CLASSROOM BLOCK

The third construction site is the ground works for what will become the classroom block of Namatala Secondary School. This is a very exciting project as it has a foundation footprint that is far bigger than the whole of the Maternity Centre!



These photos show just how complex the earthworks have been. An enormous amount of soil has been moved to dig the deep excavations for the foundations.
